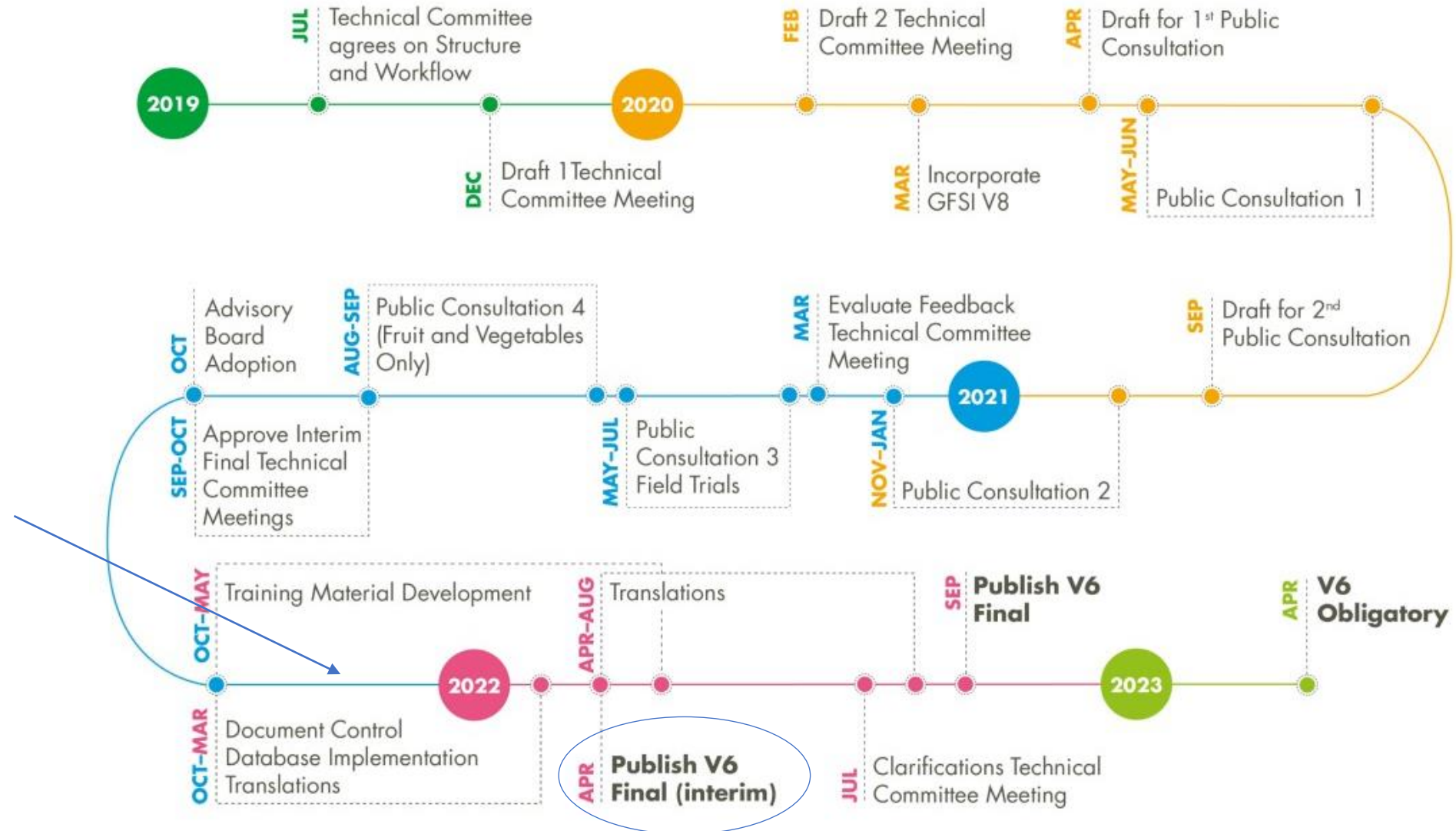

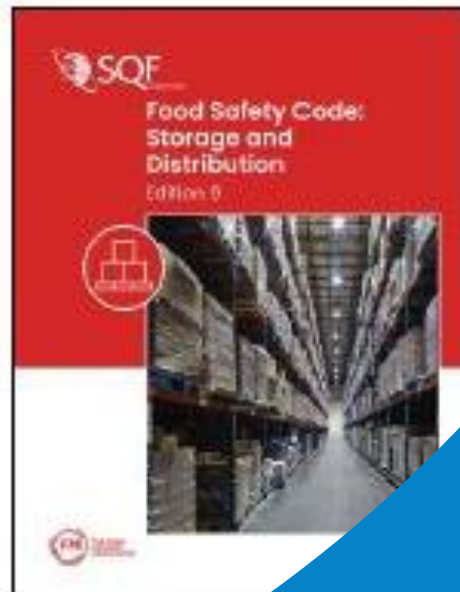
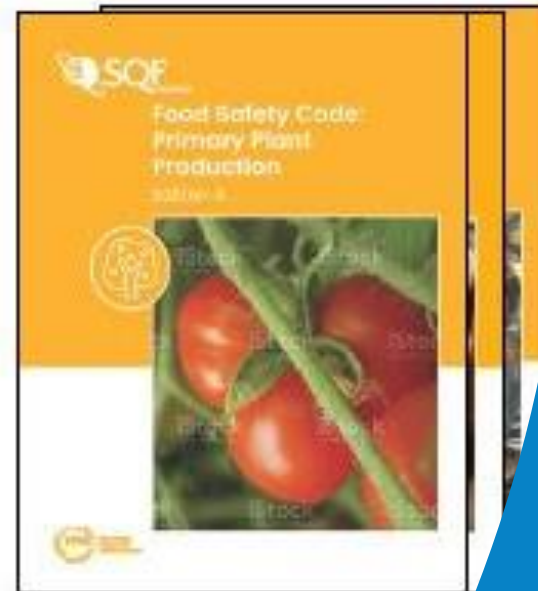

SQF Codes Edition 9

- Implemented on May 24, 2021.
- Industry specific Codes for manufacturing and primary
- No desk audit required.
- Requirements for the use of ICT.
- Modified scoring change.
- Stronger requirements for food safety culture, labeling requirements, and in-house testing.
- Enhanced requirements for primary plant water management.

Review

- IFS Working Groups updated the Food, IFS PACsecure, Logistics, Broker standards – all now recognized by GFSI.
- Introduced IFS Global Markets PACsecure Program

Looking forward

- Increase food safety awareness across the entire supply chain with focus on [IFS PACsecure](#) for packaging and [IFS Logistics](#) for distribution
- Strengthen auditor development and recruitment

- CanadaGAP Program was re-benchmarked to GFSI Version 2020.1 earlier in 2021

Effective April 1, 2021:

- 100% passing score for GFSI-recognized certification options
 - Option B Group Certification
 - Option C Individual Certification
 - Option D Repacking and Wholesaling
- Other CanadaGAP certification options require 85% and no Autofail items to successfully pass an audit

CANADAGAP  [®]

Effective October 1, 2021:

- Unannounced Audits for GFSI-recognized certification options = No prior notice of the auditor's arrival
 - Option B Group Certification
 - Option C Individual Certification
 - Option D Repacking and Wholesaling
- Other CanadaGAP certification options receive 2 to 5 business days' notice before an unannounced audit
 - Option A1
